Adobe Guadalupe was born 23 years ago. Tru and Donald Miller came to the Guadalupe Valley in the mid late 90s and started their vineyard, a retiring project and an homage to Tru's late son Arlo.

They made history in Baja by being the number 6th winery in the valley and paved the road for a new generation of excellent wines. Nowadays Adobe's wines are present in some of the most renowned restaurants in Mexico and Southern California.

WINEMAKER Ing. Daniel Lonnberg. Originally from Santiago de Chile, completed his studies in Enology at the University of Chile. In 2003 he received a job offer from Mexico and fell in love with our region. He joined Adobe Guadalupe full time in 2012.



Jardín Secreto

Vintage: 2020

An earthy, creamy, full-bodied Tempranillo, Mourvedre, Nebbiolo and Grenache blend with a distinct, slightly salty aftertaste with a dark berries finish.

Its elegant and delicate tannins and pleasant acidity make this wine accesible to all palates. It has a nicely balanced nose, is smooth and delicious with hints of oak and spices, chocolate and pepper, leather and salt.
